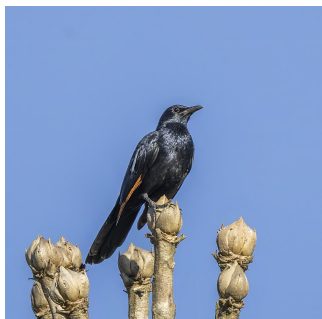

A little play. A little discovery.

- 1. Meet them.** Start with two or three cards. Let your child pick a bird, hear its name and call, and try copying the sound together.
- 2. Play together.** Lay out the cards. Play a mystery call in the app and find its bird. There is no timer and no score.
- 3. See what sticks.** Notice favourite birds, help needed with scanning, and whether your child asks to play again another day.

A grown-up should help with cutting. Keep the volume comfortable. Birds make many different sounds; these are examples from real field recordings. Some clips include background sounds. Names use your device's English voice when available.
